Dear Colleagues,

The European Pediatric Surgeon's Association (EUPSA) has the pleasure to announce the 9th Central & Eastern European Course in Pediatric Surgery on the topic of "Surgery of Congenital Malformations" in Podgorica, Montenegro.

Congenital malformations of the various organs still present enormous challenges to pediatric surgeons in terms of investigations, surgical approach and long term outcomes. Although, techniques and approaches have been standardized based on evidence based evaluations, the presence of multiple anomalies in some of these neonates presents with management dilemmas.

The 9th Course has been planned to provide an excellent overview on the management of congenital anomalies. The Course includes lecture sessions with ample of discussion time to interact with the faculty throughout the duration of the Course.

Podgorica is the capital and largest city of Montenegro. In contemporary history, the city was also known as Titograd from 1946 to 1992 during the existence of Yugoslavia. The area is crossed with rivers and the city itself is only 15 kilometers north of Lake Skadar. The Morača and Ribnica rivers flow through the city, while the Zeta, Cijevna, Sitnica and Mareza flow nearby.

The University of Montenegro was founded on 29 April 1974. when three faculties (Economics, Engineering and Law), two colleges (Teaching College and Maritime Studies College) and three independent scientific institutes (History, Agriculture and Biological and Medical Research), signed an Agreement on Association into the University in Titograd. A year after it was founded, it changed its name into the University "Veljko Vlahović", and since 1992 it has its present name. The Faculty of Medicine and Podgorica Medical School were officially established in 1997.
